
Attachment A Keelboat Course:

Course Description

From the starting line,

- Proceed to one of the Olympic circle marks per flag displayed for your class and round it to port
- Enter the harbor by the South entrance, leaving the detached breakwater to port. Drop spinnakers so that the head is below the lowest spreader before crossing the extension of the seaward side of the southern section of the detached breakwater. Leave to starboard the end of the south jetty, including any adjacent red "shoal" buoys.
- Sail down the channel staying in the sail only portion (between the "NO SAIL" buoys). The line between these buoys on each side is considered a "continuous obstruction". For purposes of this race, consider it hazardous to cross these lines.
- In the main channel, round the first center channel marker near and in front of the USCG station, leaving it to port. Leave to port all center channel markers, speed markers. The line between these buoys is considered a "continuous obstruction". For purposes of this race consider it hazardous to cross this line.
- Proceed to the finish line off Burton Chase Park dock,

Distances from Mark **SS** are as follows:

Mark **H** = 0.5 NM; Mark **S** = 1.0 NM; Mark **D** = 2.0 NM
 Mark **DD** = 2.5 NM; Mark **T** = 3.0 NM.
